Emergency Injury Disaster Loan (EIDL)

Keep checking SBA website!

- Up to 10K grant
- Now available to agriculture

EIDL & PPP

If you have received an EIDL cash advance prior to the disbursement of the PPP loan, the EIDL advance may be deducted from the total of the PPP loan approval.



Payroll Protection Program (PPP)

Expected to go quickly! First round exhausted in 9 days

- 2.5 x monthly avg payroll
- To be used for next 8 wks
- Can all be forgiven, if 75% is used for wages
- Remaining 25% for rent, utilities, interest




